Household Hazardous Waste Special Collections: June 1 – Brookfield and June 15 – Delafield

Waukesha, WI – Two Waukesha County communities will hold special one-day collections of household hazardous waste in June. The City of Brookfield will hold its special collection on June 1. The City of Delafield's special collection will be on June 15. Both collections are from 8 a.m. until noon and are open to any resident in Waukesha County.

June 1 – Brookfield Public Works – 19700 Riverview Drive
June 15 – Delafield Public Works – 111 Main Street

Old, unusable chemicals, pesticides, wood preservatives, solvents, oil-based paints, and mercury-containing products will be accepted. Latex paint and non-hazardous cleaning materials will not be accepted.

Waukesha County's four year-round collection sites are located in Muskego, Waukesha, Menomonee Falls, and Franklin. For more information, including a detailed list of acceptable household hazardous waste materials, visit waukeshacounty.gov/hazardouswaste or call 262-896-8300.
