Shall the School District of Menomonee Falls, Waukesha County, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$32,700,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a district-wide facility improvement program consisting of: facility upgrades and improvements, including roofs, exterior walls and windows, HVAC, plumbing and electrical, water mains, doors, flooring, restrooms and site improvements; demolishing the Thomas Jefferson and Hiawatha buildings and related site improvements; renovating and modernizing classrooms and learning spaces, labs and libraries; upgrading technology infrastructure; updating the North Middle School auditorium and ADA entrance accessibility; constructing a secure main entrance at Shady Lane Elementary School and parking improvements; and acquiring furnishings, fixtures and equipment?
